Looking for FREE native trees and/or shrubs?

The Robeson EAC has partnered with PA IPL/10Million Trees to offer free native trees and shrubs to homeowners who remove invasive plants from their properties and replace them with natives.

These are small plants up to 4ft tall and will come with stakes and tubes.

Native plants provide essential food and habitat for birds, butterflies and other wildlife in our community and are the basis of a thriving ecosystem. Invasive plants, including bush honeysuckle, Russian olive, butterfly bush, and Norway maples, outcompete and displace natives.

Not sure what invasive plants may be in your yard, or what these native plants look like in real life? Join the EAC at one of these events this fall and learn all about them!

- **Sat., Sept. 27, 9:30 am** - Green Hills Preserve for a guided walk. Meet in the parking lot.
- **Sun, Oct. 5, 2 pm** - Friends of Nolde Forest open house. Meet at the mansion.

The rules:

- Pre-registration is required. **Deadline: September 20th**
- Open to residents of Robeson Township (priority) and neighboring communities (as supply allows)
- Limit: 10 plants per household
- Residents agree to remove 1 invasive for each plant received. Property owners are responsible for invasive removal and any related costs.
- This is a request form, not an order form. You will indicate the number of native trees and shrubs that you want, tell us what species you are interested in, and we will allocate plants according to availability. Plants will be confirmed before pick-up.
- Pick-up will be on Sunday, September 28 from 11am-1pm at the Robeson Township police headquarters at 2689 Main Street, Birdsboro, PA.
